

South Africa Fire Arm
Importation Procedures and
Suggestions

For Johannesburg International Airport

1. Fill in the temporary firearm import permit. Use **black ink** and it must remained unsigned. For assistance you can send it to Adele at: hunterspermitsafrica@telkomsa.net , she will charge a handling fee or have it ready with the other documentation , upon arrival at Johannesburg International Airport. PHASA (PROFESSIONAL HUNTERS ASSOCIATION OF SOUTH AFRICA) can also assist you , at a small fee and they can be contacted at : admin@phasa.co.za
2. Complete SAP 520 form
 - Complete page 2 -E Natural persons details
 - Complete page 4 -G Import /Export details
 - Complete page 5- I Details of firearms and ammunition
 - Complete page 6- J Signature of applicant or
 - Complete page 8 –N Signature of Nominee / authorised person (client should give written permission for this)
3. Certified copy of passport
4. Certified copy of airline ticket / itinerary
5. Certified copy of proof of export (this is proof that your fire arms have been legally exported from your country of residence. If your country does not have an official export permit the SAPS require a letter from a government agency of your country of residence stating this. For USA citizens the 4457 form is acceptable)
6. Certified copy of firearm licences. For USA citizens the 4457 form is acceptable
7. Invitation letter of Hunting Outfitter to include: (Invitation letter on outfitters letterhead)
 - Name of person being invited
 - Duration of hunters stay
 - PH details and licences
 - Outfitters details
 - Physical address where hunt will take place with contact numbers
 - List of animals to be hunted and rifle calibres recommended
8. Upon arrival at Johannesburg Int. Airport the Fire Arm office is in Terminal 2 , in front of the **Post Office**
